2	An ordinance of San Bernardino County, State of California,		
3	to repeal and replace Section 308 of the County Charter, and		
4	adding Section 309 and Article VIII to the County Charter relating to law enforcement staffing and community		
5	protection, and ordering that such proposal be submitted to the qualified electors at the November 5, 2024 election.		
6			
7	WHEREAS, San Bernardino County, State of California, at all times herein		
8	mentioned has been and now is a body corporate and politic of the State of California a		
9	since April 7, 1913 has been and now is organized and acting under and by virtue of a		
10	Charter adopted under and pursuant to then Section 7 ½ of Article XI of the Constitution		
11	of the State of California, which Charter was duly ratified by the qualified electors of said		
12	County at an election held for that purpose on November 5, 1912, and approved by the		
13	Legislature of the State of California on April 7, 1913;		
14	WHEREAS, said County Charter has been amended several times pursuant to the		
15	procedures set forth in the Constitution and statutes of the State of California; and		
16	WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to place before the voters proposed		
17	amendments to the County Charter.		
18	NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernarding		
19	State of California, ordains as follows:		
20	SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of Article XI of the Constitution		
21	of the State of California and of Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 23700) of Division		
22	1 of Title 3 of the Government Code of the State of California, the proposed amendments		
23	to the County Charter, as set forth in Attachment "A" hereto, are hereby approved.		
24	SECTION 2. The proposed amendments to the County Charter shall be submitted		
25	to the electors of San Bernardino County at an election to be held and conducted on		
26	November 5, 2024. It is further ordered that the election be consolidated with any and all		
27	elections in the same territory to be conducted on November 5, 2024. The election will		
28	be held and conducted by the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters as required by		

1	federal and state law and all of the proceedings incidental to and connected with the		
2	election shall be regulated and done in accordance with the provisions of law regulating		
3	the election with which this election is consolidated.		
4	SECTION 3. The proposed amendments to the County Charter shall be submitted		
5	as a measure on the ballot at the consolidated election, and the Registrar of Voters is		
6	hereby instructed to place the same on the ballot at said election in the following form:

17	SECTION 4. The language set forth in Attachment "A" shall be printed in the Voter		
18	Information Guide that is mailed to every qualified voter in the County and placed on file		
19	and made available for public inspection in the offices of the County Clerk, the Registrar		
20	of Voters and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.		
21	SECTION 5. Measure "" shall go into effect only if approved by a majority of		
22	the qualified voters voting in an election to be held on November 5, 2024. To the extent		
23	permitted by law, these amendments to the County Charter shall be effective upon voter		
24	approval of the Measure as provided by California law. On the effective date of this		
25	Measure as provided by California law (the "Effective Date"), these amendments to the		
26	County Charter are inserted into and become part of the San Bernardino County Charter.		
27	No provision of the San Bernardino County Code of Ordinances that is inconsistent with		
28	this Measure shall be enforced after the Effective Date.		

SECTION 6.
