NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following measure is to be voted on by qualified voters residing within Rim of the World Recreation and Parks District at the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026.

Measure “ _ ”

Shall Rim of the World Recreation & Park District adopt a resolution increasing its annual special parcel tax from \$22 to \$37/parcel, with an annual escalator of 1%, until ended by voters, generating approximately \$510,000 the first year, to sustain essential recreation services; improve and maintain parks, recreational facilities, and community amenities; address rising costs, emergency repair and disaster recovery; all funds remain local used only for these purposes with annual audit/ reporting?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that this measure will pass only if approved by two-thirds of the district's registered voters who vote in this election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that noon on August 17, 2026, is the last day and hour that arguments for or against the measure may be filed by mail, email, fax or in person with the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters. Arguments shall not exceed 300 words in length and shall be accompanied by the statement set forth in Section 9600 of the Elections Code. NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that 5 p.m. on August 21, 2026, is the last day and hour that rebuttals to the arguments for or against the measure may be filed by mail, email, fax or in person with the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters. Rebuttals shall not exceed 250 words in length and shall be accompanied by the statement set forth in Section 9600 of the Elections Code.
