A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RIM OF THE WORLD RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF PRIMARY AND REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS AND SETTING RULES FOR THE FILING OF WRITTEN ARGUMENTS REGARDING A DISTRICT MEASURE TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE NOVEMBER 3, 2026 GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTION

WHEREAS, a General District Election is to be held in the Rim of the World Recreation and Park District, California on November 3, 2026, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

Shall Rim of the World Recreation & Park District adopt a resolution increasing its annual special parcel tax from \$22 to \$37/parcel/year, with an annual escalator of 1%, until ended by voters, generating approximately \$510,000 the first year, to sustain essential recreation services; improve and maintain parks, recreational facilities, and community amenities; address rising costs, emergency repair and disaster recovery; all funds remain local used only for these purposes with annual audit/ reporting? NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RIM OF THE WORLD RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Primary Arguments. That the Board of Directors authorizes (i) all or any member(s) of the Board of Directors, (ii) any individual voter eligible to vote on the above Measure, (iii) a bona fide association of such citizens or (iv) any combination thereof, to file a written argument in favor of or against the District Measure, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, in accordance with Article 1, Chapter 4, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, and to change the argument until and including the date fixed below by the District Secretary, after which no arguments for or against the District measure may be submitted to the District Secretary.

The deadline to submit primary arguments for or against the District Measure pursuant to this Resolution is declared by the District Secretary to be **Monday, August 17th at Noon**

p.m. Each argument shall be filed with the San Bernardino Registrar of Voters, signed, and include the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument.

Section 2. Rebuttal Arguments. Pursuant to Section 9317 of the Elections Code of the State of California, when the District Secretary has selected the primary arguments for and against the District Measure(s) which will be printed and distributed to the voters, the Secretary shall send copies of the primary argument in favor of the Measure(s) to the authors of the primary argument against, and copies of the primary argument against to the authors of the primary argument in favor. The authors or persons designated by them may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not exceeding 250 words. The rebuttal arguments shall be submitted to the San Bernardino Registrar of Voters no later than **Friday, August 21 at 5:00p.m.** Rebuttal arguments shall be printed in the same manner as the primary arguments. Each rebuttal argument shall immediately follow the primary argument which it seeks to rebut.

Section 3. Prior Resolutions. That all previous resolutions providing for the filing of primary and rebuttal arguments related to District measures are repealed.

Section 4. November 3, 2026 Election. That the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 shall apply only to the election to be held on **November 3, 2026** and shall then be repealed.

Section 5. Certification. The District Secretary shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
