Observation Schedule June 24, 2025, Bear Valley Community Healthcare District **Special Mail Ballot Election**

The public is invited to observe as the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters office according to the following schedule:

May 22, 2025

- Election Observer Training begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed prior to the start of the Logic and Accuracy Testing.
- Logic and Accuracy Testing of the County's ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 9 a.m.
- May 27, 2025 Processing of mail ballot return envelopes begins at 10 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.*
- June 5, 2025 Extraction and processing of mail ballots begins at 10 a.m. and is performed daily. Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.*
- **June 12, 2025** Counting of mail ballots begins at 10 a.m. and continues periodically, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.*
- June 25, 2025 The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before July 11, 2025.
- **July 2, 2025** The random batch selection for the one percent manual tally of mail ballots counted on the ballot scanners takes place at 2 p.m.
- **July 3, 2025** The one percent manual tally of mail ballots counted on the ballot scanners begins at 10 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until complete.
