





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Candidate filing begins May 5 for Baker Community Services District







Qualified citizens may file candidacy documents for member of the board of directors for Baker Community Services District. At the time a person obtains candidacy documents, they must be a registered voter residing in the district.



Citizens interested in running for this office may obtain the appropriate candidacy documents from the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters, 777 E. Rialto Avenue in San Bernardino from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Completed documents must be filed with the Registrar of Voters by 5 p.m. on Friday, May 30. The Registrar of Voters will be closed on May 26 in observance of Memorial Day.

About San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters: The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters is responsible for all aspects of the election process for the county's residents. It administers local, state, and federal elections in San Bernardino County, including the management of voting systems, the employment and training of poll workers, election ballot processing, and vote tallying. The Registrar of Voters also performs all voter registration functions, including the storage and maintenance of voter registration records. It also provides voting-related services to voters, elected officials, campaigns, and other voting interest groups.
