Mail Ballot Drop-off Locations March 24, 2026, City of Ontario Special Election

For the March 24, 2026, City of Ontario Special Election, the Registrar will provide mail ballot drop-off locations for the public to securely return their mail ballots. Each location has been surveyed and determined to be accessible to voters with disabilities. Voters using a drop-off location must deliver their ballot no later than 8 p.m. on Election Night.

The following staffed, indoor ballot box will be available beginning Monday, February 23, 2026, through Election Day, during regular business hours as indicated.
