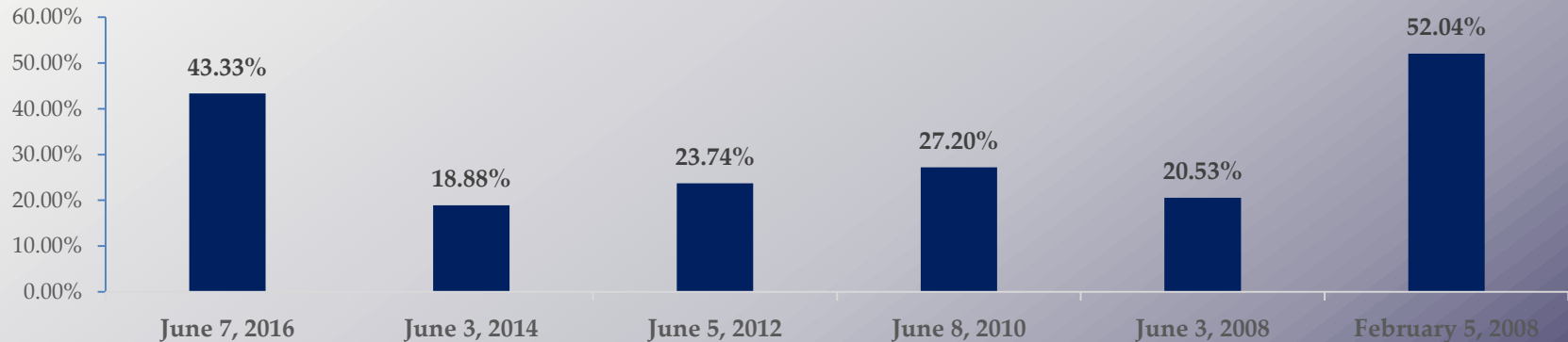

Historical Voter Turnout

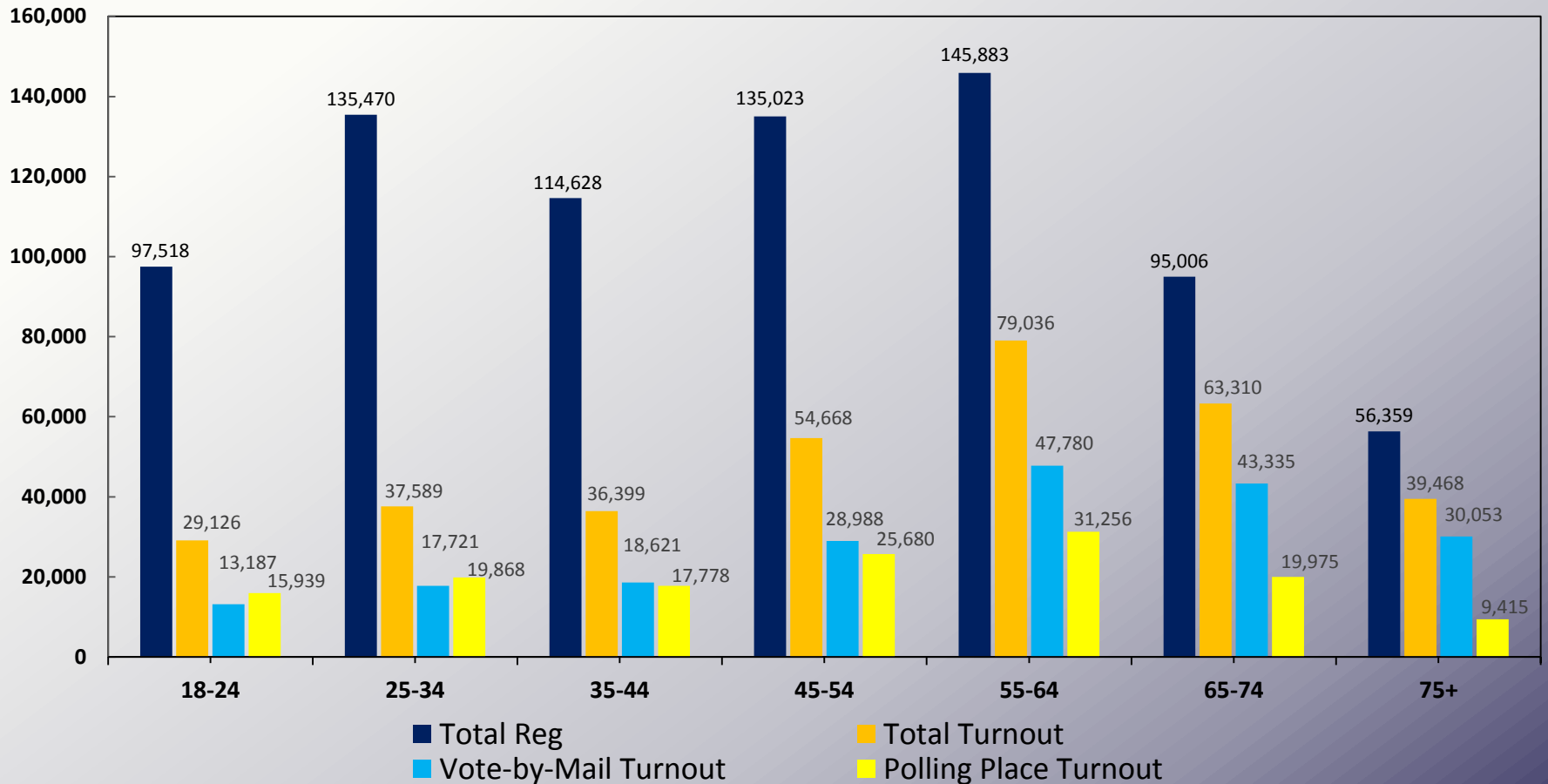

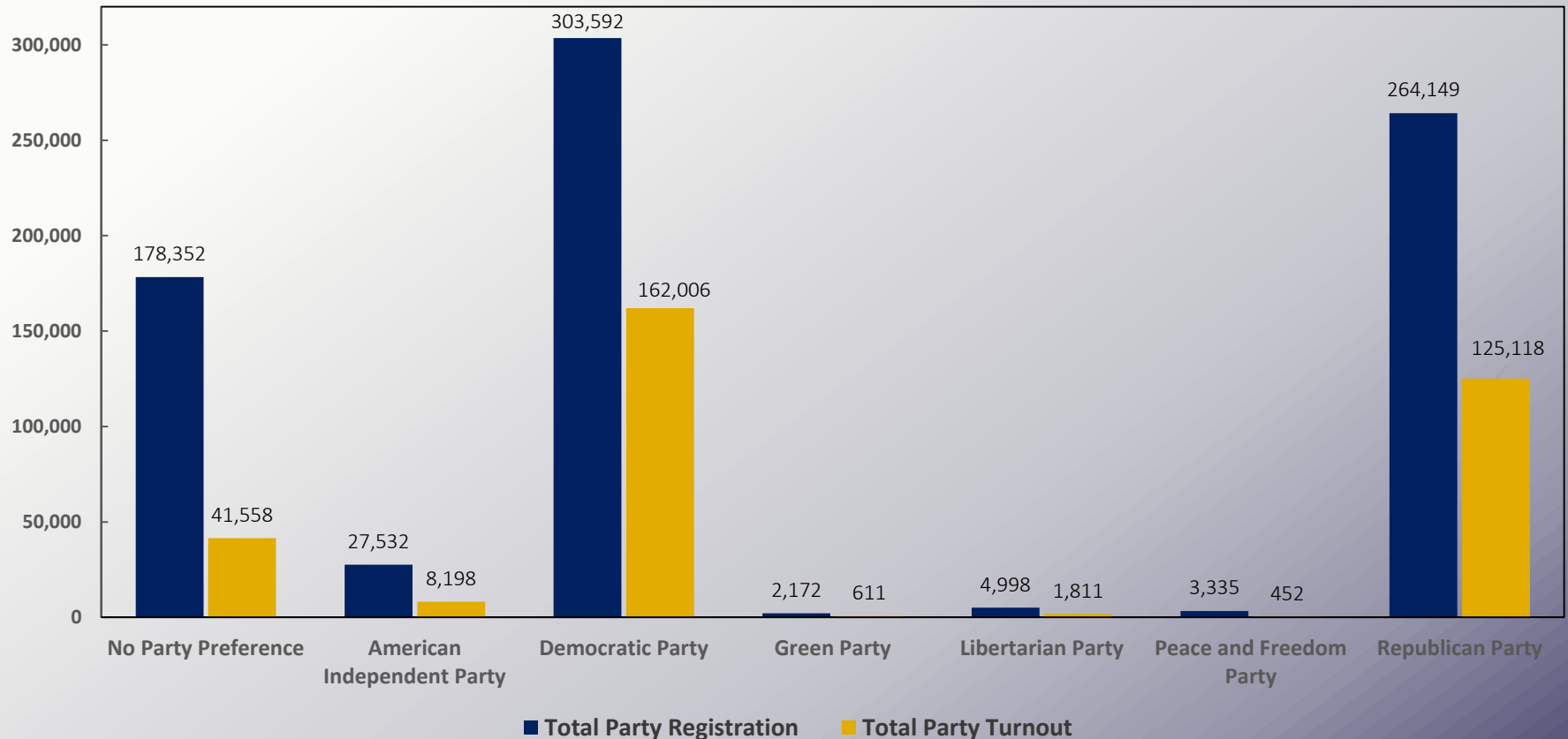

 - 5 early voting locations
 - 180 contests
 - 475 candidates
 - 23 local measures
 - 17 state propositions

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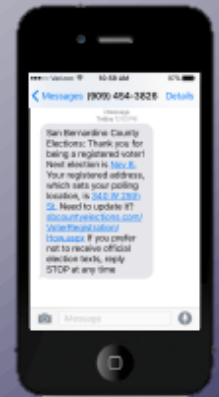
■ Important Election Dates

- Friday, Oct 7 Voter Information Guides delivered
- Tuesday, Oct 11 Early voting begins (Elections Office)
- Friday, Oct 14 Mail Ballots delivered
- Monday, Oct 24 Voter registration deadline
- Monday, Oct 31 Early voting expands (4 locations)
- Tuesday, Nov 1 Deadline to apply to vote by mail
- Tuesday, Nov 8 Election Day

- Ambassador Program
 - Voter education and community outreach
 - Focus in targeted areas
 - Hard to recruit areas
 - Low voter registration areas
 - Recruitment and training coming soon
 - Need volunteer recruitment referrals
 - Need speaking engagement referrals



- Elections Office Messaging Program
 - Personalized election information (mail ballot tracking, election information) directly:
 - From the Elections Office website
 - Via email
 - Via text messages
 - Increase awareness of early voting, vote-by-mail, online Voter Information Guide



- National Voter Registration Day
 - Tuesday, September 27, 2016
 - Voter registration trainings – Tuesdays at 10:30 a.m.

- Expand Ethnic Media contacts
 - Increase access to election information
 - Disseminate poll worker information
