Rebuttal to the Argument against Measure A

A person who isn't from our area has submitted a boiler plate argument that has nothing to do with our measure, Rialto USD or our students. This is not okay. The health and safety of our kids is on the line.

Please join hundreds of parents, teachers, students and community members in supporting our LOCAL Rialto USD schools and voting YES on Measure A.

FACT: Many Rialto USD schools were built over fifty-years ago and need urgent repairs and upgrades.

YES on Measure A removes asbestos, lead paint and mold; replaces leaking roofs, decaying walls, broken plumbing and bathrooms; upgrades electrical systems and wiring for computer technology and installs new windows and proper insulation.

FACT: Many Rialto schools have outdated security and safety features, from aging smoke alarms/fire safety to inadequate safety lighting, fencing, and emergency communications systems.

YES on MEASURE A keeps students safe by upgrading campus security so that we can keep intruders out.

FACT: All four of our local high schools - Carter, Eisenhower, Rialto and Milor High – need significant upgrades to help students prepare for college, jobs and careers.

YES on A removes outdated, deteriorating portable classrooms and upgrades science and engineering labs so our kids have the education they need to succeed.

By law, Measure A includes strict fiscal accountability including a Citizens Oversight Committee and annual audits. All Measure A funds must be used for Rialto schools and cannot be taken by the State.
